**Dear Colleagues;**

It is my greatest pleasure to announce Vusi Sindane's appointment as TGH's COO effective 01 January 2020. A brief background is necessary to contextualize this important appointment.

### **1. Background**

Vusi's journey with TGH begun with his introduction and subsequent association with Vulani Mabunda in Ermelo, Mpumalanga around 2011/12. Vusi started doing consulting work for Habana Trading (TGH's scholar transport subsidiary) around 2014. Vusi moved to TGH's head office in Sandton around February/March 2016, attached to Vulani's R&D and Business Development Directorate. I would occasionally bump into Vusi during this time and had no clue what he was doing. It was around July/August 2016 when Vulani approached me to introduce Vusi in absentia, suggesting that he (Vusi) would be a better fit in my office. Thereafter, Vusi was introduced to my office as Executive Assistant. The rest, as they usually say, is history.

Fortunately, I have never been one to judge a book by its cover. Vusi's diminutive nature and unassuming demeanour can be misleading. At face value, there is no way anyone can tell the intellect, wisdom and wealth of knowledge Vusi commands. Many of you pitied Vusi's role as my Executive Assistant because of my known perfectionist and demanding requirements. Contrary to this view, it is now common knowledge that Vusi has grown into a pillar of strength at TGH, particularly within the Executive Chairperson's office. Vusi is such an excellent and competent colleague whose capability, commitment, dedication and enthusiasm are a rare inspiration to me and, I believe to almost everyone at TGH. Vusi's contribution has and continues to make an indelible mark on the vision, leadership and management of TGH.

# About Vusi

# Formative Years

Born in Mpumalanga, in a small village called Maganagobushwa [those who refuse to be ruled], Vusi started his first business in primary school, selling sweets and sandwiches. In high school, he sold airtime, phones and other electronics. At the same time, he completed an A+ course to fix computers and later learned to develop software, whilst in high school.

Due to financial constraints at home, he started a Microsoft Certified Solutions Developer (MCSD) program after school but did not complete it. Nevertheless, he developed time-tabling software and sold it to schools in Ekurhuleni. He then started a software consulting business where he hired his lecturer on projects and built a team to help clients automate business processes with software.

In 2007, he helped implement an enterprise resource planning (ERP) platform for supporting the supply and delivery of stationery to over 3000 schools in KZN. In 2009, Vusi played a key role in importing, localising and implementing tracking technology, which monitors more than 10,000 government vehicles today.

More recently, Vusi held several executive and non-executive directorships and served as the Group COO of Tirhani Group Holdings, managing a portfolio of 16 companies. Among others, he led the disposal of non-core properties for the Department of Infrastructure Development (GDID), disposing more than R100m in assets. He also led several restructuring efforts and organisational improvement initiatives to navigate the Group through COVID-19 and meet other strategic objectives.



# Executive Roles

Between 2018 – 2020, in his capacity as project director, Vusi led the promotion and revitalisation of the South African auction industry in partnership with the Services SETA. He delivered the first industry-wide auction conference, represented by professional bodies and industry leaders in every sub-sector of auctioneering. He also delivered the first industry-wide research paper (co-developed with Plus94™), and over-hauled SSETA's auction qualifications to align with SAQA standards.

In 2021, Vusi was appointed executive director of Nyukani Education Centre, a private school in Limpopo. In three months, the school implemented e-learning across the board (from Grades 0 – 12), eliminating all COVID disruptions, particularly during the 3rd wave. The school seamlessly switched to remote learning during the lockdown period of June 2021 and then back to blended learning when contact lessons resumed.

Within 10 months, with the introduction of e-learning, management restructuring, and systems changes, the school's academic performance improved by an average of 10% across all grades compared to the previous years. The Matric class of 2021 doubled their distinctions and produced the best Matric results since inception – a 96% pass rate. In the first term of 2022, the school produced the best matriculant in Limpopo and the best results in the circuit.

# Unsupported Cycle challenge: for 3257km from Musina to Cape Town for 10,000 School Shoes

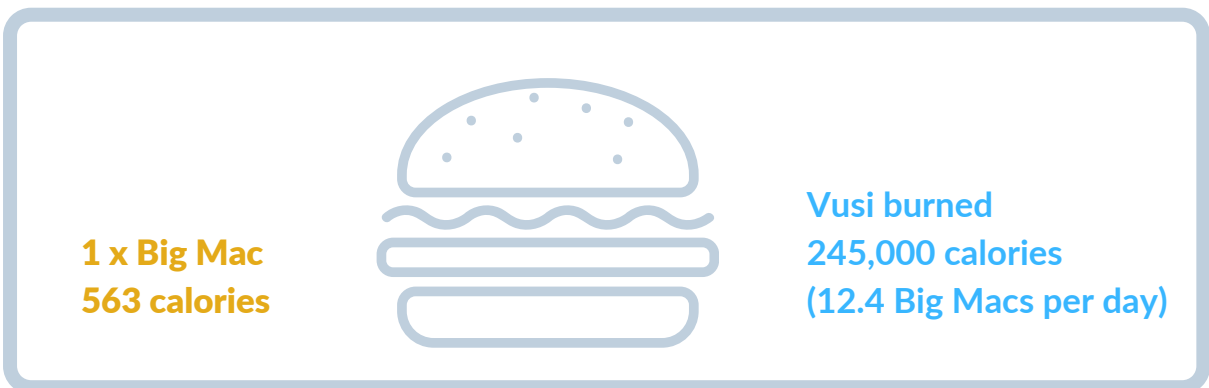
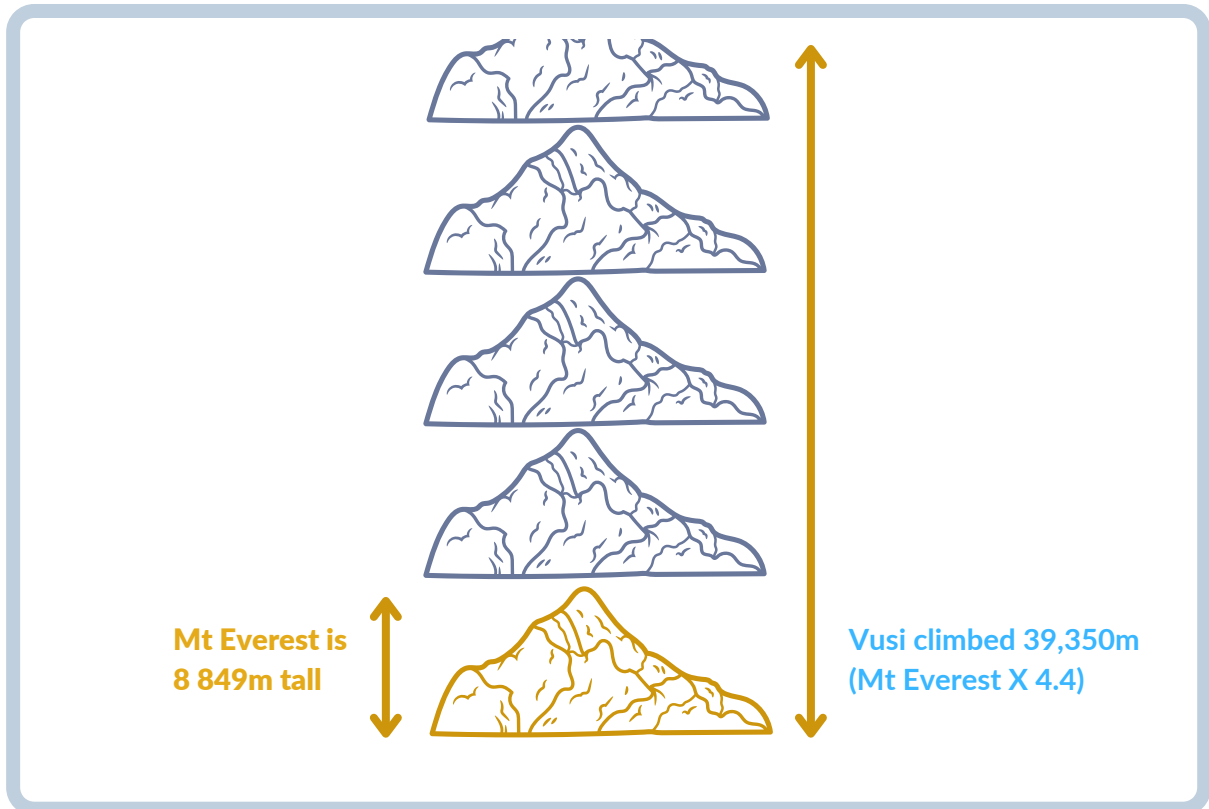
On 13 April 2023, Vusi Sindane made history by cycling the full length of South Africa, unsupported with a mountain bike.

He started the journey at Beit Bridge in Musina and ended at Green Point in Cape Town. His mission was to raise funds to buy 10,000 school shoes for underfunded children around South Africa.

Vusi cycled 3257km to reach Cape Town and managed to raise 1511 pairs of school shoes. Undeterred, Vusi is now partnering with companies and schools across South Africa to raise funds for the remaining school shoes.

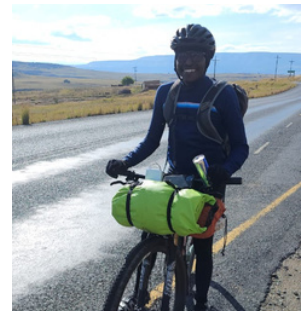
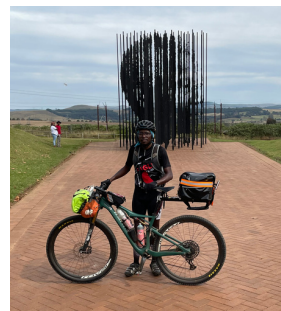


# Fun Facts Of Cycling 3257km Musina to Cape Town for 10,000 school shoes
